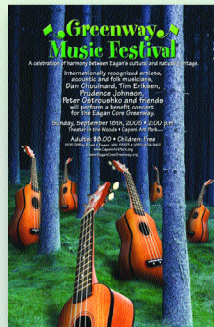


# Greenway Music Festival

**The second annual Greenway Music Festival**, sponsored by the Friends of the Eagan Core Greenway (FOECG), is dedicated to preserving the Eagan Core Greenway for future generations. This year, the second annual festival will focus on supporting the Caponi Art Park, a remarkable space in which nature and the visual and performing arts exist in harmony.

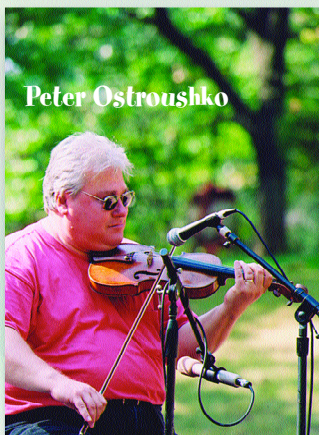


The Eagan Core Greenway, which includes the Caponi Art Park, is a 500-acre strip of woodland and natural glacial terrain in the heart of Eagan, Minnesota's 8th largest city. FOECG is organizing the Greenway Music Festival both to help preserve the Caponi Art Park and to fund future efforts to educate the community about the significance of open space.

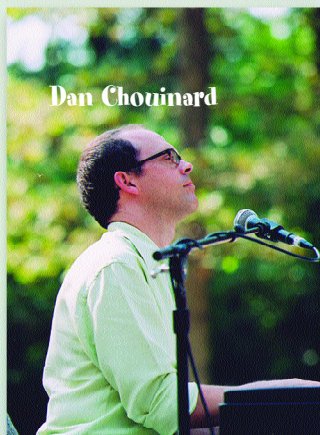

and expect to have musicians of the same caliber, and we look forward to doubling the size of last year's audience.

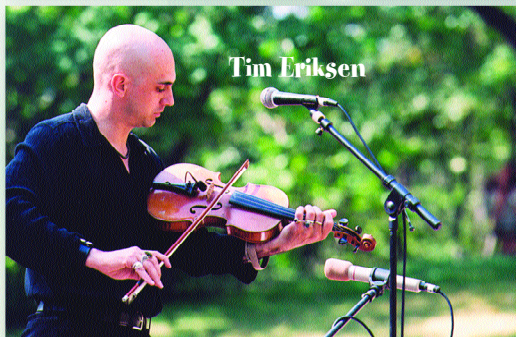
FOECG welcomes members of our community to the Greenway Music Festival, which will both increase awareness of the Art Park and take steps toward ensuring its survival.

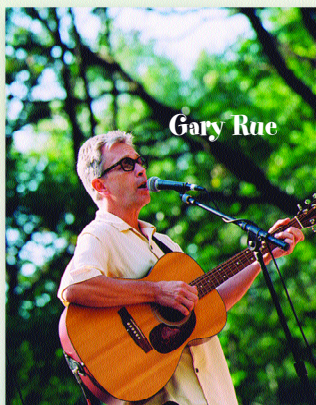
